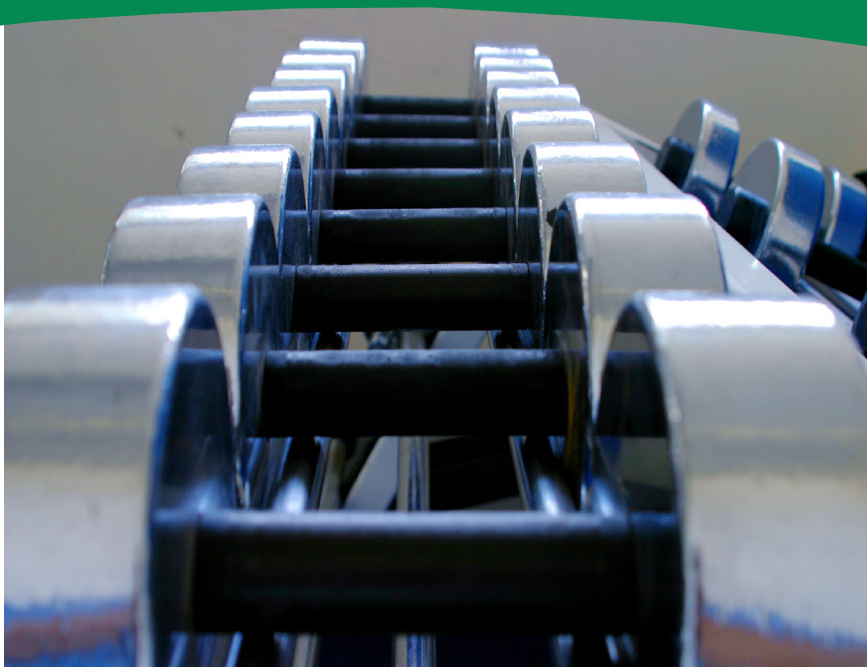
Qualified Federal Financial Aid Program
