PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The program is a master certified program through the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF). The program, along with actual work experience in the automotive repair field, prepares the student to be a Master ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) Technician. The National Institute for Automotive Service Excellence (ASE), certifies technicians. The program has eight areas of completion including electrical systems, engine repair, engine performance, heating and air conditioning, brakes, steering and suspension, manual drive train, and automatic transmissions. Certificates are given for successful completion of each area and a master completion certificate is awarded to students who successfully complete all eight areas. Prepares the student with the skills necessary for employment as an entry-level automotive technician. Upon completion of the program students are prepared to take ASE certification tests.
